## Squirrel Wreath

What you Need:

Large Paper plate or cardboard Brown wrapping paper Construction paper Popsicle stick Pencil Scissors Glue Markers



How To:

- Cut out your wreath base from a large paper plate or cardboard. The center hole should be smaller than the length of the popsicle stick.
- 2. Cut out a long strip of brown wrapping paper about 2-3 inches wide and start wrap the wreath base with brown paper. Wrap the whole wreath and secure the ends with glue.
- 3. Cut out the leaves and acorns from the template (or make your own) and glue them on the wreath
- Cut out the pieces for the squirrel template (or make your own). Glue the squirrel's face to the head. Then, glue the forelegs, bottom legs, and the tail to the squirrel's body.
- 5. Glue the nose and draw the squirrel's face using markers.
- 6. Glue the squirrel to a popsicle stick.
- 7. Glue the squirrel to the wreath.
